At The Due West Ranch in Kansas City, Kansas

The Due West Ranch is proud to be hosting a clinic with Buck Davidson. Buck was ranked 3rd nationally in 2006 and has represented the United States at the Pan American Games. He was short-listed for the 2000 Olympic Games and the 2004 World Equestrian Games. Most recently he was selected as an alternate for the 2008 Olympic Games in Beijing and was selected as one of two American riders to represent the United States in the inaugural Express Eventing competition to be held in the United Kingdom in November. Buck uses a logical progression of exercises to help develop horse and rider confidence while presenting new challenges. Format: The clinic will be held on Saturday and Sunday. We will do grid work on Saturday and show jumping coursework on Sunday. Groups will be an hour and a half and will have 3-5 riders per group. The Due West Ranch has a large indoor arena with heated viewing area for auditors and an outdoor arena with all weather footing. A full course of show jumps will be available for our use. Schedule and times will be e-mailed.

Stabling: Stalls are available at Due West Ranch for \$20 per night including bedding. Go to www.theduewestranch.com for more details.

Cost: \$300 per rider or \$150 per day. 2-day participants will be given priority over 1-day participants. Entries are due on November 25. We need to have a critical number of committed riders to buy his plane ticket and make plans for his accommodations. Refunds will not be given unless the clinic is cancelled or a vet certificate is presented. Make checks payable to Mary Cook.
